What is ORANGE2?

ORANGE2 is a multisample library based on the sounds of Waldorf Microwave XT synthesiser.

The orange coloured synthesizer of the German **Waldorf** is a legend: there is nothing like its sound, and it has inspired lots of performers since its appearance in 1995. **Microwave XT** is a virtual analogue instrument, which produces the sound by using the spectral wavetable synthesis developed by Waldorf GmbH, and combines it with 10 types of extremely good quality filters.

ORANGE2 is an ultimate collection for computer musicians providing a comprehensive selection of these marvelous timbres.

Abbreviations

We used these abbreviations at the end of the patch name. They will help you to find what you are looking for.

V : The velocity switched version of the patch is marked with -V at the end of the file name.

A, B, C, D: they indicate the different versions of the patch: in general, -A is the most hollow version, -B is brighter, etc.

The numbers in parentheses (where applicable) indicate the number of different sound variations. The other number in the right column shows the patch size in megabytes.
